**PGT** (Chemistry, Physics, Biology, Maths, History, Geography, Economics, English, Hindi, Commerce, IT, Food Production & Beverage and Bio-Tech.)

**TGT** (Hindi, English, Science, SS, Maths, Urdu, Punjabi and Marathi)

**Age as on 01.04.2018: up to 62 years (for retired teachers from Govt. controlled institution)**

### **ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA FOR PGTs**

PGTs (Food Production & Beverages)	Degree/3 Years Diploma in Hotel Management with 60% marks in degree/diploma in Hotel Management.
PGT (English)	Post Graduate in English
PGT (Hindi)	Post Graduate in Hindi
PGT (Phy.)	Post Graduate in Physics/Applied Physics/Electronics Physics/Nuclear Physics
PGT(Chem.)	Post Graduate in Chemistry/Bio Chemistry
PGT(Maths)	Post Graduate in Maths/Applied Mathematics
PGT (Eco.)	Post Graduate in Economics/Applied Economics/Business Economics
PGT(Biology)	Post Graduate in Botany/Zoology/Life Science/Bio Sciences/Genetics/Micro Biology/Bio Technology/Molecular Bio/Plant Physiology provided that applicant had studies Botany and Zoology at Graduation level.
PGT(History)	Post Graduate in History

TGT (Maths)	Maths, Physics & Chemistry.

TGT (Hindi, English)	Candidate must have studied Hindi, English, Urdu as Elective Subject at Graduation Level.
TGT 3 <sup>rd</sup> Lang.	Candidate must have studied concerned 3 <sup>rd</sup> Language as Elective Subject at Graduation Level (CTET is not required for TGT 3 <sup>rd</sup> Lang.).

Practical experience of two years in Hospital/ Clinic. <b>DESIRABLE:</b> Working knowledge of Hindi/ Regional Language and English.

**NB:**

- i) Preference will be given to the CTET qualified candidate (Paper-II) for TGTs only conducted by CBSE.
- ii) In absence/non-availability of above candidates preference should be given to those candidates who had worked earlier in Central Govt. Organization.
- iii) Retired teachers up to the age of 62 years may be engaged subject to their fitness and willingness.
- iv) Some candidates may have completed their graduation through 10+2+2 system instead of 10+2+3 system as was existing in various universities and hence marks for three years of Graduation are not available. In such cases marks for two years of Graduation as indicated by the University would be considered to decide eligibly.

v) The applicants with qualification other than B.Ed. like L.T. from SCERT, Prabhakar with Graduation, PGDTE from CIFL, D.Ed. and B.T.C. are not considered.

vi) Percentage of subjects/degree not mentioned-To be verified carefully.

vii) Bachelor of Elementary Education four years study is not equivalent to B.Ed.
